On December 20, 2004, 429 Penn Partners (appellant) appealed the final decision of a General Services Administration contracting officer terminating appellant's rights to proceed with the performance of lease number GS-05B-16772 for premises to be occupied by the Small Business Administration in Indianapolis, Indiana.
